AUSTRIAN LINE INFANTRY REGIMENTS 1850-1860

IN 1850 THE AUSTRIAN ARMY HAD 58 LINE INFANTRY REGIMENTS, WHICH BORE THE REGIMENTAL NUMBERS OF 1-63. SOME NUMBERS WERE UNUSED; FOUR MISSING REGIMENTS WERE RAISED AGAIN IN 1851 FROM CONVERTED BORDER GUARD INFANTRY REGIMENTS, AND NR. 63. WAS RENUMBERED TO NR 55. IN 1852. FROM 1852 A TOTAL OF 62 LINE INFANTRY REGIMENTS EXISTED, 19 OF WHICH WERE RECRUITED FROM THE HUNGARIAN PART OF THE EMPIRE. THE DRAFTING WAS DONE BY A DRAW. THOSE WEALTHY ENOUGH TO PAY A SUBSTITUTE COULD AVOID THE 8-YEAR SERVICE IN THE ARMY. LINE INFANTRY REGIMENTS CONSISTED OF 4 FIELD BATTALIONS (EACH 6 COMPANIES STRONG) AND A GARRISON BATTALION (4COMPANIES STRONG). THE FORMERLY INDEPENDENT GRENADIER COMPANIES WERE MOVED BACK UNDER DIRECT COMMAND OF THE REGIMENT. EACH BATTALION HAD A GRENADIER COMPANY. THE COMPANY STRENGTH WAS AROUND 129 MEN IN PEACETIME AND 221 MEN IN WARTIME. A LINE INFANTRY REGIMENT'S TOTAL STRENGTH WAS AROUND 2830 SOLDIERS IN PEACETIME AND 6886 SOLDIERS IN WARTIME.

UNIFORM:

SHAKO:

THE M1850 SHAKO WAS MADE OF WATERPROOF FELT WITH LEATHER TOP AND VISOR.

ABOVE THE VISOR A LEATHER BAND WAS ATTACHED WITH A BUCKLE AT THE BACK.

ATTACHED TO THE FRONT WAS A BRONZE IMPERIAL EAGLE SURMOUNTED BY A BRASS COCKADE.

ON CAMPAIGN, AN OAK (SUMMER) OR PINE (WINTER) BRANCH WAS STUCK BEHIND THE COCKADE.

TUNIC:

THE TUNIC (WAFFENROCK) WAS WHITE WITH TWO ROWS OF BUTTONS (ORIGINALLY 8, LATER REDUCED TO 6) WITH COLLAR, CUFFS, SHOULDER STRAPS AND PIPING IN FACING COLOUR. HUNGARIAN REGIMENTS HAD A DECORATIVE WHITE BRAIDING ON THE CUFFS CALLED 'BEAR PAWS'. EACH AND EVERY REGIMENT HAD A FACING AND BUTTON COLOUR COMBINATION WHICH IDENTIFIED THE REGIMENT.

TROUSERS:

HUNGARIAN REGIMENTS WORE THE TIGHT, LIGHT BLUE HUNGARIAN TROUSERS WITH A YELLOW/BLACK BRAID (VITÉZ-KNOT) ON THE THIGHS AND SEAMS ON THE SIDES.

SHOES:

EARLIER THERE WERE "HUNGARIAN" AND "GERMAN" SHOES, BUT FROM THE 1850'S ONLY THE "HUNGARIAN" STYLE WAS USED BY ALL REGIMENTS. MADE OF BLACKENED COW-SKIN, ONLY ONE TYPE FOR BOTH LEFT AND RIGHT LEG.

EQUIPMENT:

KNAPSACK:

THE KNAPSACK HAD A SIZE OF APPROXIMATELY 25 X 30 X 10-13 CM AND WAS MADE OF CALFSKIN LINED WITH CANVAS. THE STRAPS WERE WHITENED LEATHER.

CARTRIDGE BOX AND BELT:

MADE OF WOOD LINED WITH CANVAS INSIDE AND COVERED WITH BLACK LEATHER. THE BELT AS WELL AS THE BAYONET BELT WERE MADE OF WHITENED LEATHER.

MUSKET:

THE WEAPON OF THE SOLDIER WAS AN M1842 AUGUSTIN INFANTRY MUSKET.
